## **Action Two: Calls/Letters**

NATIONAL LEVEL - Congress is back in session. From the folks at CMSM - there is a likely vote in the Senate on SJ Res 54 to activate Congressional War Powers to end full U.S. participation in the Yemen War. So far, we have succeeded in the U.S. ending refueling of Saudi planes, but we continue to directly participate in other ways that need to end. Call your Senator today to support this resolution: 1-833-786-7927

NATIONAL LEVEL - Stop the deportation of Oneita, Clive and Suyapa so they can keep their families together. They came here from Jamaica and Honduras fleeing violence and have been wrongly denied asylum. Sign the petition to stop their deportation:
