I need you to commit to a vote supporting Dreamers, or else 800,000 young people who are American in almost every way will face deportation. We can't let that happen."*

NATIONAL LEVEL - It has been 16 years since the Guantánamo detention facility opened for business. Nearly 800 individuals have been detained at Guantánamo there since it started in January 2002. Most detainees have been there for over a decade, and the majority have never been charged with any offenses. Toffiq al-Bihani has been stuck in Guantánamo for 14 years without charge or trial—take action now and demand his transfer.
