Action Two: Calls/Letters

We want to make sure that the House does not pass the Senate version as-is. Tomorrow: Undocumented youth are leading a campaign to take over MoC's offices across the country to demand they stand for Dreamers. All week long. Call your Senators. Visit www.dreamerpledge.org to find out if your Senators have taken the Dreamer Pledge. Then grab your phone and dial 1-855-980-2355.

NATIONAL LEVEL - Call your representative in Congress and tell them to pass legislation that creates a solution for ALL families who could lose TPS: (202) 224-3121

NATIONAL LEVEL - We need every member of the House to hear that their inaction is unacceptable. Call your representative at 888-704-9446 and tell them to pass the DREAM Act now to ensure young immigrants can stay in the country without fear?

NATIONAL LEVEL - Share The Journey - Right now, the Administration is considering how many people will find refuge from persecution in the United States for 2018.
